Outcomes and destinations



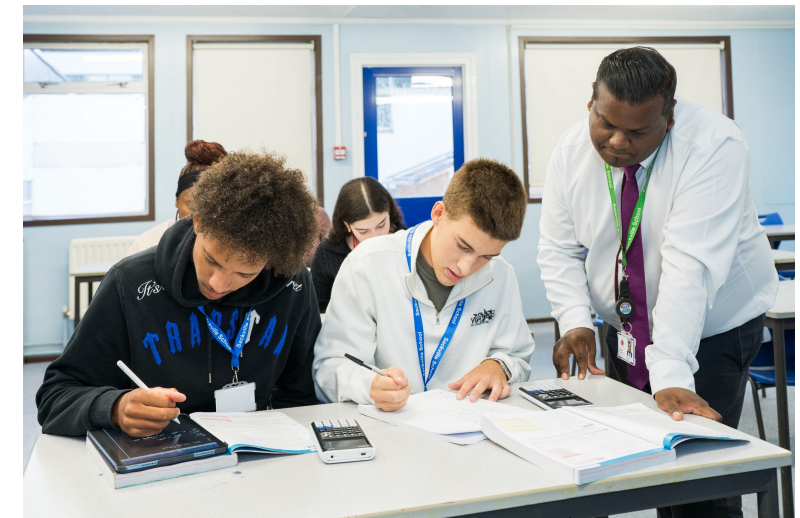
2025 results:

- Vocational results exceeding national performance



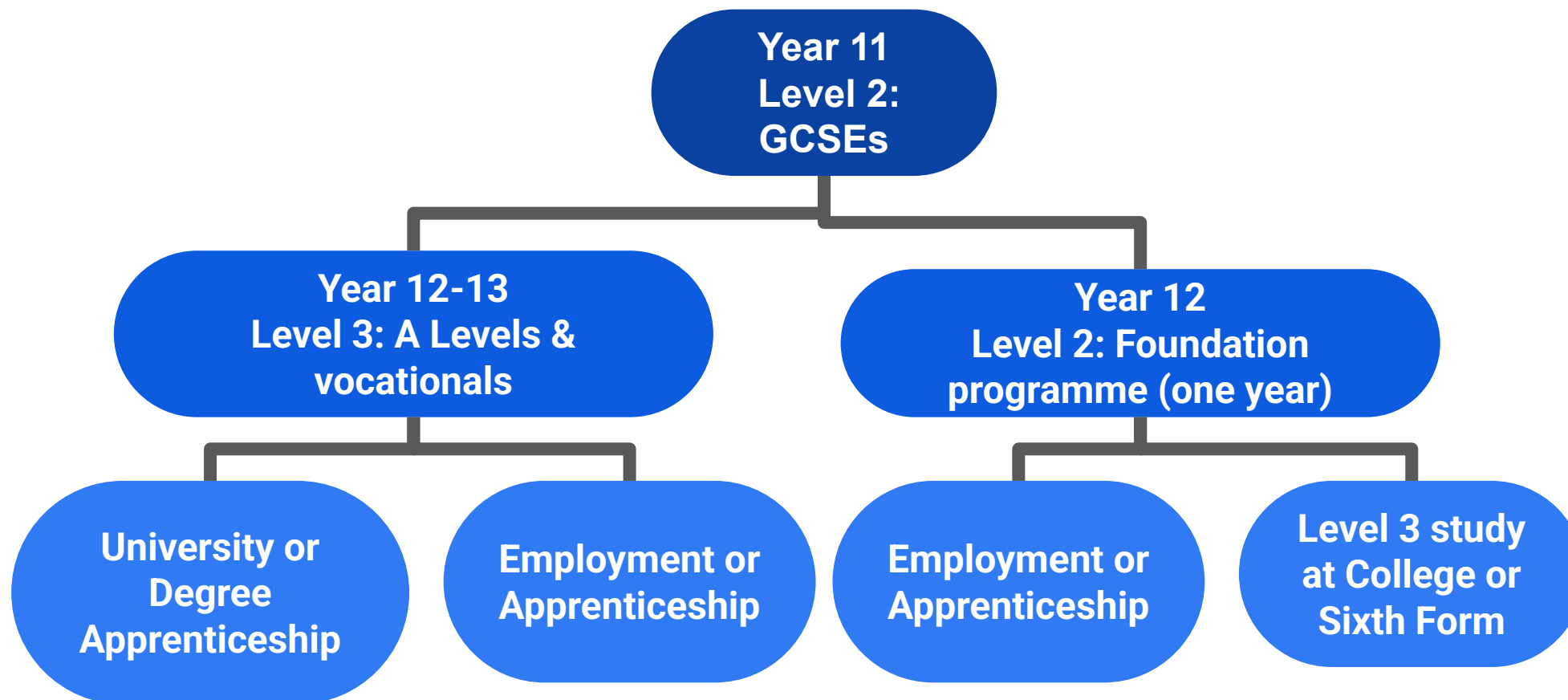
Student destinations:
