Booking procedure:

Please be aware that opportunities are selected on a first come, first serve basis. If your first choice is fully booked, there will be a waiting list for you to join, that will inform us of your interest. Please do not just join a waiting list and not select any other option to avoid disappointment.

All residential deposits are non-refundable, but are sometimes transferable to another trip if a space becomes available, this is before any cut off points that are imposed upon us by the travel companies. In the event that an opportunity does not meet the minimum number of students required to make the trip viable, it will be cancelled. If this happens, you will be informed by 17 November 2025 and every effort will be made to get you onto your second choice.

All full payments for non-residential activities are non-refundable or transferable.

We are excited to begin preparations! CEW is always a huge success and every year the students are able to take advantage of a huge range of opportunities and experiences that we believe so strongly in and create long lasting memories.
