## Tower of London Trip – Monday 16 March 2026

We are delighted to invite your child to participate in an exciting and historically rich school trip to the Tower of London. This excursion is specifically designed to enhance their learning about the Tudor period, bringing their classroom studies to life.

The trip will take place on Monday 16 March 2026. The Tower of London, a site deeply tied to the dramatic lives of Tudor monarchs and their unfortunate rivals, offers a perfect opportunity for immersive historical study.

A key part of the day will be an exclusive "Prisoners of the Tower" workshop, delivered by the expert team at Historic Royal Palaces. This interactive session will explore the lives and fates of famous (and infamous) figures held within the Tower's walls, providing a fascinating look at the political turmoil of the Tudor age.

The cost covers transport, entry to the Tower of London, and the specialist workshop.
