Students on the GCSE Drama course have the exciting opportunity to watch a production of 'The Play That Goes Wrong' on Thursday 18 December at The Duchess Theatre, London. The performance is a phenomenal comedy that will allow students to complete the written Live Theatre evaluation in their Component 1 written exam at the end of Year 11.

We will be traveling to London by train, which has been included in the price. We aim to be back at East Grinstead train station at 11.15pm. We ask that you make arrangements to collect your child at this time. I will ensure that students keep you updated on our timings.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £32.00, which will cover the cost of the ticket and the train journey. I must however tell you, that as the school could not bear the cost of the visit, the visit will not take place unless parents, who are able to, are willing to contribute. In the unlikely event that a student has to be removed from the visit due to poor behaviour, we reserve the right not to refund the voluntary contribution associated with this visit.

We never want cost to be a barrier preventing members of our Sackville Community from our culture of belonging or from being able to take part in trips and events. We will work closely with all families to ensure that every child has equitable access to opportunity, during their time at Sackville School. If any families would like their child to take part in this opportunity and would need financial assistance, we invite families to get in touch with us to discuss what may be available.
