## Year 12 and 13 Physics Trip to London - Friday 21 November 2025

On Friday 21 November 2025 we are planning a trip to London to Physics in Action at the Emmanuel Centre in London. This is an opportunity for students to listen to people talk about some of the most up to date and interesting research within the field of Physics.

As all of the students are 16+ years old, we think it is a good opportunity for them to get practised at travelling independently. We will meet students at the 'accessible meeting place' near platform 13, opposite the toilets in Victoria Station, London, and walk them to the Emmanuel Centre from there. At the end of the day we will return students to Victoria, who can make their own way home.

We strongly recommend travelling from East Grinstead station by train. The train they need leaves at 9.06am and arrives at London Victoria at 10.02am. This is the first off-peak train, and the last train that gets them to London Victoria on time. An off-peak return costs approximately £20.00, but may be cheaper with a railcard. If they are travelling from another station, they need to be at the 'accessible meeting place' in London Victoria for 10.05am.

Please can you complete this [Google Form](#) to give your permission for your child to go on the trip. Also, if you would prefer them to travel with a member of staff from East Grinstead station, you can let us know on the form.

Students should bring a packed lunch and plenty to drink as there will be limited opportunity to buy refreshments while we are in London. Students should wear comfortable shoes for walking around the city and do not need to wear school uniform. Please ensure students have a waterproof jacket to cover all eventualities with the weather!

The cost of this trip is £33.00 and payment needs to be made via MCAS on or before Tuesday 18 October 2025, as I need to confirm the final number attending on this date. There is a maximum of 15 places available for this trip.
