We are really looking forward to 'Bring It On', the students have been working incredibly hard in preparation and we are really proud of them.

Ahead of show week we wanted to share with you some helpful information of how the evening performances run and the weekend rehearsal.

### Tickets

### Show T-Shirts and Permission

We are planning to order show t-shirts which you can wear during rehearsals and show week. You can choose what you would like on the back of your t-shirt e.g. your character name, band name or your own name. The purchase of these t-shirts is totally optional. If you would like a t-shirt, the cost is £14.00. Please make payment via the My Child at School app by Thursday 29 January 2026. We also ask that you fill out the Google form [here](#), indicating the size required and what name you would like on the back. You will also be giving consent for your child to take part in the show on this form.

In order to avoid the task of chasing up missing permission forms we kindly ask that these are completed as soon as possible - thank you for your understanding.

### Costumes

A costume list for all cast will be supplied by this Friday. It will be uploaded to Google Classroom. We ask that students bring all costumes, a hanger and a bag in by Friday 06 February 2026.

### Rehearsal - Sunday 08 February 2026

The rehearsal will run from 10.00am - 4.30pm, all students involved should register in the main hall. Please can students bring lunch with them as the canteen will be closed. **No peanut or nut related products are allowed on school site, please can we also ensure that no fish or fish related products are taken in to school also.** They can wear their own clothes to the rehearsal but please can we ask that no one wears jeans.

### Show week

- **Friday 06 February 2026** – The cast and band will spend the day rehearsing together. Students should register in their tutor groups and then make their way to E block. All students must wear school uniforms. Please note the cast have a rehearsal after school until 5.00pm.
- **Monday 09 February 2026** - All students involved in the show will be off timetable all day to rehearse. Rehearsal will finish at 4.30pm. Students are able to wear their own clothes.
- **Tuesday 10 February 2026** - Primary School Matinee - Students should come to the main hall at the start of break. The matinee will finish at lunchtime. All students should wear school uniforms and then change into their costumes.
- Students should arrive for show evenings at 4.30pm on the Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings. All students must sign in and out on show evenings, the register will be placed in the dining hall.

- The show run time is approximately 2hrs including an interval.

**Refreshments for students:**

Water will be available for students on the evening of the shows. Students should bring their own snacks if they wish. **Again, no peanut, nut related products or fish or fish related products are allowed on the school grounds.**
