Taster day at Chichester University – Tuesday 27 January 2026

Dear Families

We have been invited to attend a taster day at Chichester University on Tuesday 27 January 2026. The course runs from 9.30am-3.30pm and we would travel by minibus, leaving school at 7.45am and returning at approximately 4.45pm. The day aims to give students an opportunity to experience the courses offered by The Institute of Sport, Nursing and Allied Health through fun and interactive taster sessions. They will provide a variety of sessions across a range of sport, nursing and allied health. All sessions will be led by the university staff and the student ambassadors will also lead campus tours exploring the labs, sports facilities, health facilities and teaching spaces. The students will then finish the day with a session looking at what university admissions tutors will be looking for in their UCAS personal statements.

Any disruptions to travel, we will ask students to contact you to update.

Students are required to bring a packed lunch with them. **No nuts or nut related products are allowed to be taken on any school visit.**
