### New Booking Process

- Platform: All after-school sessions will now be listed in the "Clubs" tab on the home screen of the MCAS app. Lunch time sessions remain 'free to turn up' for this term.
- Action required: You must book a space for your child for any after-school club they wish to attend.
- Availability: Places are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Key date: Bookings will go live on Wednesday January 07 2026, at 7.00am.

### Why are we making this change?

Moving to the MCAS app ensures our session leaders have immediate access to vital information, such as educational and medical needs, as well as emergency contact details. It also offers several benefits for you and your child.

- Rewarding students: We can easily award two community points for every session attended.
- Communication: We can notify you instantly via the app if a session is cancelled.
- Safeguarding: You can view your child's attendance in real-time, providing peace of mind regarding their whereabouts.
