Sackville School Expectations – Important Reminders

At Sackville School, we believe that our uniform policy plays an important role in supporting high standards, a sense of belonging and equality among our students. Recently, we have noticed an increase in uniform infringements and would like to clarify our expectations to ensure consistency.

Branded Sackville Jumper:

- Only the school jumper to be worn and **not** alternatives such as (Sackville PE) hoodies or sweatshirts
- These should be worn at all times, the exception being the second half of the summer term when we move to our summer uniform

Skirt:

- Navy skirts should be worn at an appropriate length, just above the knee

Trousers:

- Tailored school trousers should be black or grey
- No leggings, flared trousers or flared leggings are permitted

Socks:

- Socks should be plain black or navy and of standard length
- No other coloured or fluffy socks, or socks with visible logos

Shoes:

- Shoes must be plain black and have no visible/non-black logo

Hair / Make Up and Jewellery:

- Hairstyles must be tidy, natural in colour, and appropriate for a professional learning environment
- Extreme hairstyles are not permitted
- Students in Years 7–9 should not wear make-up, from Year 10 onwards, light and natural-looking make-up may be worn
- Excessive or obvious make-up is not permitted
- Nail varnish, acrylic nails, or false nails are not allowed
- Students may wear one small stud earring in each ear and a wristwatch
- No other jewellery is permitted

Consequences for infringements:

Students who do not adhere to uniform expectations may be:

- Asked to change into school-provided uniform
- Given a reminder or warning

- Issued further consequences if non-compliance continues

We appreciate your support in upholding our standards and ask you to please check your child's uniform daily to ensure it meets the above requirements. If you are unsure about any aspect of the uniform policy, please check out our policy following the link below:

I would also like to take this opportunity to remind families that all students should arrive each day at school with the correct equipment to support learning which includes:

- Black and green pen
