It was a pleasure to meet with so many of you last evening. As Ms Colburn and I shared during our meetings, we have reached a vital stage in the academic year. Our current focus is on finalising coursework with last-minute refinements and beginning intensive preparation for the upcoming examinations.

Many of you enquired about specific revision topics and resources. While the mock examinations were supported by a targeted checklist, the final examination covers the entirety of the R093 module of the J278 Creative iMedia qualification.

To support your child's preparation, I have developed a comprehensive eleven-week revision timetable. By dedicating just 1.5 hours per week to iMedia revision, students will be able to cover the entire syllabus before their examination on Monday June 08 2026.
