### Travel and Logistics

Students are expected to travel independently by train. Please note the following schedule:

- **Arrival:** Students must meet Ms Kaur at the Westfield Vue Cinema entrance no later than 9.40am to ensure a prompt start.
- **Dismissal:** Students will be dismissed directly from the venue at the end of the conference (3.15pm) to make their own way home.

### Attendance and Cost

The school has fully funded the cost of this conference, but students will pay for their own travel costs. Because of the significant investment and the proven positive impact these sessions have on final grades, we believe all Year 13 economics students should attend.

This is a fantastic opportunity for the cohort to step outside the classroom environment and focus intensely on the skills required for their upcoming papers, especially after the disruption that they have faced over the two year course.

Students will need to bring lunch with them or have some money available to buy lunch in the Westfield centre. **No peanut or nut related products are allowed to be taken on any school visit.** There is a lunch break of between 45 and 60 minutes to enable this to happen.
