The B&V team is running a series of after-school revision sessions in the run-up to the GCSE exams (3.00pm - 4.00pm in different locations). The first three sessions are tailored to meet specific needs (so students are not expected to attend them all). Teachers will invite certain students, but all are welcome to come along without an invitation.

Students should attend the room they normally have B&V in, or if that is not offered, they can go to any room where there is space available:

**Wednesday 22 April: 12-marker clinic (L01, L02, L03, T04) 3.00pm - 4.00pm**

**Wednesday 29 April: Securing a grade 4 (L01, L02, L03, T04) 3.00pm - 4.00pm**

**Friday 1 May: Aiming for a grade 6+ (L01, L02, T04) 3.00pm - 4.00pm**

The final three sessions are the traditional 'cramming sessions' in the canteen. These are really to be viewed as last minute reminders of key content and techniques, and should not be the main or only revision students do! Everyone is welcome to attend these, but much of this content will already have been covered in revision lessons:

**Wednesday 6 May: Islam cramming (Canteen) 3.00pm - 4.00pm**

**Thursday 14 May: Themes cramming (Canteen) 3.00pm - 4.00pm**
