The students should arrive at Chequer Mead to start rehearsals at 8.45am, students do not need to attend school beforehand. Students will then spend the day rehearsing at the theatre and will take part in an evening performance starting at 7.00pm.

Students will need to bring enough food and drink to sustain their energy for the duration of the day. **No peanut or nut related products are allowed to be taken on any school visit.**

During the day we will have two designated breaks where students can either leave the theatre and purchase food and drink or go to the dressing room. We suggest that students bring some revision resources or homework with them to complete whilst they are not on stage. We suggest they either wear comfy clothes or their PE kit during the day.

7.00pm - Performance begins

8.30pm - Collection from the theatre
