Allsorts LGBTQ+ Family Support and Opportunities at Sackville School

I wrote to families earlier in the year with new LGBTQ+ opportunities for our students to get involved in at Sackville School, including available support from Allsorts and extra curricular opportunities.

Shortly after, we launched our exciting new lunchtime club "Together we Belong", celebrating equality and diversity among all in our community, including those who are part of the LGBTQ+ community and allies. This has provided a valuable space for students to come together, make new friends and take part in a range of creative activities and arts and crafts.

As you will be aware, we are fortunate to be working in partnership with the youth charity Allsorts this year, in collaboration with West Sussex County Council.
