In order for you to be fully informed, we have tried to break our trip down for you:

Luggage and Clothes

The weather will most likely be sunny when we are in Paris.

- Please make sure you bring comfortable/suitable footwear and ensure you bring suitable clothes: appropriate length garments and garments that protect you from UV.
- Please also bring some sun cream.
- Do not forget to bring a euro travel adapter and charger.
- You are allowed one rucksack for food on the coach and to carry your water bottle. A small holdall is advised for the rest of the luggage with dimensions no greater than 50cm x 30cm x 30cm. **No peanut or nut related products are allowed to be taken on any school visit.**
- You are advised to bring a contactless card, preferably a Mastercard to get the best exchange rate. We predict you may spend in the region of 80 euros.

Passports and Visas - On 08 July at 3.30pm, I will be sitting in reception with my list of passengers. Please, can you bring me your child's passport and GHIC card as well as any visa documentation they may need at this time. Medications can also be brought at this time if preferred.

Student Meeting - We will meet as a student body to go over final bits and pieces on 06 July in P01, please make sure students attend.
