## Pride Week - June 2026

I am delighted to share with you our plans for our latest focused week, on the theme of inclusion 'Sackville Pride Week 2026' which will take place Monday 22 June - Friday 26 June 2026.

This forms part of a larger initiative we have developed this year, to highlight and celebrate many aspects of the rich fabric of society and culture including diversity, disability awareness, Black History Month and International Women's Day.

At Sackville, we are proud to promote a culture of inclusivity, respect, and acceptance for all members of our community, as such this dedicated week has been carefully planned to:

- To raise awareness and promote inclusion
- To support members of our LGBT+ community within school
- To introduce our students to different viewpoints and life experiences of members of the LGBT+ community
- To raise money for our Student Leadership Team to invest on a student inclusion and experience improvement project

Throughout the week, all students will take part in daily tutor time sessions designed to encourage open discussion and reflection.

These will include themes around tackling discriminatory behaviours and language (both in a broader sense and within the context of LGBT+) and celebrating notable famous and influential people, who have shaped both our own school (Holmes and Turing) and those who have made significant contributions to society.

Once again we are fortunate enough, through our partnership with Allsorts, to run assemblies for each year group on Friday 26 June on the history and significance of Pride and the LGBT+ community.

There will also be a series of other optional extra curricular activities we invite students to join in with throughout the week including our Rainbow Colour Day, sweet, badge and shoe lace sales, in addition to many other smaller events run by student and staff volunteers

On Friday 26 June, we will have our Rainbow Colour day and we invite students to wear a t-shirt of their community colours (which can also be worn on sports day). T-shirts will be available to purchase on MCAS for £2.50, this covers the cost of the t-shirt. Orders should be made by 5.00pm on Thursday 11 June, which is when the order window will close. Could I then ask you to complete this [Google form](#) to request the colour and size of the t-shirt. Students will be required to wear the rest of their school uniform.
