GCSE and A-Level Spanish Immersion - February 2027

Thank you for the numerous expressions of interest regarding our GCSE and A-Level trip to Spain in February 2027. I am delighted to inform you that, given the strength of response and, following some productive discussions with tour providers, we are able to offer an exciting trip to our Hispanists during February half term, from Monday 15 - Friday 19 February 2027.

We are proposing a five-day visit to Olé Adventures, an immersion and adventure company based near Huelva, in Andalucía, the southernmost region of Spain. Throughout the five day trip, students will be fully immersed in Spanish, whilst participating in a range of activities from Canyoning and Rock climbing to team sports, cultural visits, outdoor cinema and stargazing. On top of this, students will receive high-quality Spanish lessons from qualified teachers, which we feel will be incredibly impactful ahead of their speaking exams in May of 2027 or 2028.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution to cover the cost of the trip, although I must inform you that, as the school could not bear the cost of the trip, unless all families who are able to pay the full price do so, the trip may have to be cancelled. The total cost of the visit, which is inclusive of return flights from London Gatwick to Faro, coach transfers from school and from Faro to the centre in Huelva, accommodation in Olé Adventures comfortable yurts, all meals and snacks and all activities, is £750. To secure your child's place on the trip, a deposit payment of £250 is required by Friday 26 June 2026. Payment can be made via the MCAS app.

Insurance for all school trips is arranged through West Sussex County Council. Full details of the policy can be found [here](#). **No peanut or nut related products are allowed to be taken on any school visit.**

Please note that deposits will only be refunded if the trip does not run, and that all monies forwarded to our tour provider are non-refundable. We never want the price to be a barrier to members of our Sackville Community accessing trips and visits and, if you require some assistance in this regard, please do not hesitate to contact your child's community.

As outlined in our Culture for Learning policy, on rare occasions we may have to remove a student from a trip who is unable to meet our high expectations or whose behaviour puts themselves or others at risk.

We look forward to a rewarding, memorable and enjoyable experience with our Spanish students.
