Curriculum Enhancement Week - Theatrical Production – Wednesday 15 July 2026 to Friday 17 July 2026

With our curriculum enhancement days fast approaching I wanted to provide you with more details on what is included as part of the theatrical production and dance days starting on Wednesday 15 July.

Wednesday 15 July - The Lion King - Lyceum London

- Students should meet us at school in P01 at 8.30am.
- Once students are registered and briefed on the day we will walk down to East Grinstead train station to catch a train to London Victoria.
- Once we arrive at Victoria we will make our way to St James Park for lunch, please can students bring a packed lunch with them. **No peanut or nut related products are allowed to be taken on any school visit.**
- Once we have finished lunch we will then continue our walk to Covent Garden before heading to the theatre.
- The production of the Lion King starts at 2.30pm and finishes at approximately 5.15pm. If students wish to bring some money to purchase a drink or a program we advise no more than £20.00. Please note the theatre may not accept cash.
- After the show, students will walk to Embankment and catch a tube back to Victoria.
- We will arrive back at East Grinstead train station at 6.50pm. If you wish for your child to walk home please contact Mrs Whitmore beforehand.

Please note students are permitted to wear their own clothes for the trip. However, they must adhere to theatre etiquette. Please make sure there are no bare midriffs on show or hot pants worn.

Thursday 16 and Friday 17 July

Students will take part in a series of dance and musical theatre workshops led by DMT School of Dance and Musical Theatre. Students will workshop and build towards a final performance applying the skills they have learnt. Please ensure students are wearing clothes they can move in, trainers and bring plenty of water. Students should register in room P01 at 8.25am on both days.
