Please keep an eye out for an email from us via our Applicaa application platform, we will be sending these out in the next few days. Once you receive the email you will need to reconfirm your enrolment and subject choices by logging back into Applicaa and clicking the 'Accept Offer' button. This is a vital part of the enrolment process and has to be completed by the student. This is not yet their final enrolment (which will be explained further at the transition evening), but it will help us ensure we can support you effectively.

To help you with firming up your subject choices, we have attached the option blocks for Year 12 for 2026/2027.
