School Cricket Trip to Lord's Cricket Ground – Thursday 10 September 2026

We are delighted to invite your child to join us for an exciting day of cricket at the iconic Lord's Cricket Ground on Thursday 10 September 2026.

This is a fantastic opportunity for the students to watch the National Schools Final for the Boys U15s and experience the atmosphere at the "Home of Cricket." In addition to watching high-level youth cricket, the day will feature a full program of activities, including:

- **Coaching Sessions:** Interactive sessions delivered by professional coaches.
- **Fun Cricket Activities:** Hands-on games and skill challenges throughout the day.
- **Careers Fair:** An insightful fair highlighting future employment, apprenticeship, and career opportunities within the sports and cricket industries.

Trip Details and Logistics

- **Date:** Thursday 10 September 2026
- **Venue:** Lord's Cricket Ground, London
- **Cost:** £13.00 per student (covers entry and travel)
- **Travel:** We will be traveling to London by train. **Exact departure and return times will be confirmed** once final train schedules are locked in, but please expect a full school day commitment.
- **What to Bring:** A packed lunch, a refillable water bottle, and suitable clothing for both indoor/outdoor cricket activities and the weather on the day.

We never want cost to be a barrier preventing members of our Sackville Community from our culture of belonging or from being able to take part in trips and events. We will work closely with all families to ensure that every child has equitable access to opportunity, during their time at Sackville School. We will provide full funding for our eligible Pupil Premium students, from the available grant for this opportunity. If you have any questions please get in contact with your community team.
